### HAWORTH SKILLED TRADES SCHOLARSHIP

Open to the Public - Two (2) Scholarships Available

A \$2,000\* scholarship awarded to applicants who can confirm their enrollment in an accredited technical industrial certification, associates, or skilled trades/vocational school program.

### Eligibility

- 1. Must be able to confirm you have or will obtain your high school diploma or equivalent on or before July 1<sup>st</sup> of the year in which the scholarship will be used.
- 2. ## Eligibility

- 1. Must be an eligible dependent of a member as defined by Haworth's Eligible Dependent Policy.
  - Eligible Dependent Policy: An eligible dependent child is the member's natural child, legally adopted child, or a child placed with the member for legal adoption; or the member's step-child or a child for whom the member [or their spouse] are a court-appointed legal guardian [under a full (not limited) legal guardianship].
