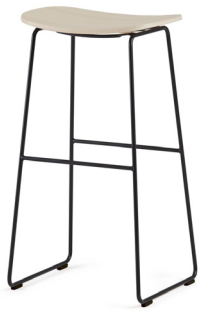

Inside in beech plywood and birch covered with multi-density polyurethane foam; fixed in fabric

The profile is closed with a piping in the same material

Painted White (TROWH)

Painted Anthracite (TROAN)

Stained Stainless steel (STOOS)

Feet and glide

Polyethylene

Grey glide
