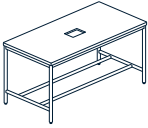

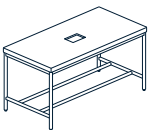

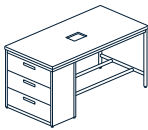
Rectangle, 1" No Storage

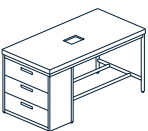
Rectangle, 2" No Storage
