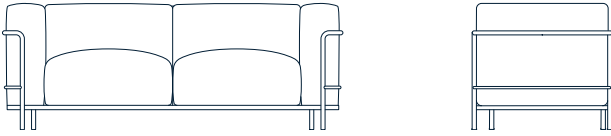

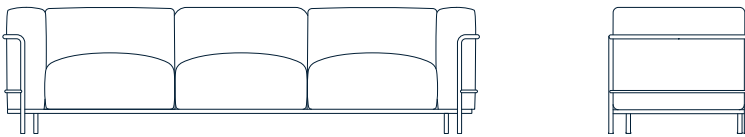


2-Seat Sofa

Le Corbusier, Pierre Jeanneret, & Charlotte Perriand

In 1922, Le Corbusier began working with his cousin Pierre Jeanneret, with whom he shared research projects and design criteria in a profound and life-long professional relationship. Five years later, the pair decided to draw on the contribution of a young architect, Charlotte Perriand. The resulting designs were of great intellectual value and considerable commercial success.
