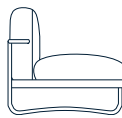
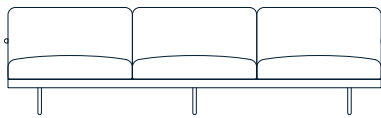


### 2-Seat Sofa
