

Charlotte Perriand

Charlotte Perriand was a pioneering French architect and designer. Known for her collaborations with Le Corbusier and Pierre Jeanneret, she contributed to iconic modernist furniture. Perriand's designs emphasized functionality and simplicity, using materials like tubular steel and aluminum. She was also an interior architect and exhibition designer, leaving a lasting impact on 20th-century design.
